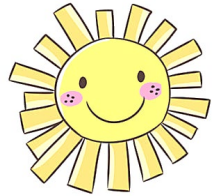

DEVICE RETURN

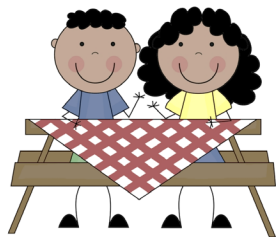
