DRESS CODE

Blue Oak Charter Council believes employees serve as role models for the students and as representatives of Blue Oak Charter School. Consistent with these roles, all employees, volunteers and substitutes shall dress professionally and appropriately adhering to standards of dress and appearance that are compatible with an effective learning environment. Administrators and administrative support employees are expected to project a professional image and should dress appropriately for the office/business environment. Games and Movement teachers should wear appropriate athletic attire necessary to meet the requirements of their job responsibilities. Clothing must be neat, clean, in good repair, and appropriate for on the job appearances.
