We have had requests from our neighbors asking if we could reduce the amount of high pitched, ear piercing and repetitive screaming from students during recesses. This will not be a quick fix but we will be trying our best to work with our students to make them aware of their screams when playing. Screaming loudly over and over is not appropriate for a school play yard and should be reserved for emergencies. We all need to be considerate of our friends with special needs, who are sensitive to loud noises, those that shy away from ear piercing noises, and those who are prone to chronic migraines. Our students don't have to be absolutely quite, but we do need to show our students that it is possible to play and have fun without screaming.
