FRONT DOOR PROCEDURE

Starting this week we will be implementing a new system for our schools front doors. To increase school safety, entry through the front doors will be locked during these hours:

Mon, Tues, Wed, Fri = 9:00AM - 2:45PM
Thurs = 9:00AM - 12:30PM

All visitors, staff, and students who want to access the building during these hours must ring the bell to be buzzed in. The doorbell can be found on the left door.

During regular drop off and pick up times, visitors will not need to be buzzed in and may come on to campus as usual. When you come into the front office, the procedures will stay the same (checking in, etc.). Please be sure to remind your students of this new procedure as well. We appreciate your patience as we navigate through this new system.
