LCAP TOWN HALL

Please join us for our annual LCAP Town Hall Discussion to give input on our schools current Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP). The Town Hall discussion will be a hybrid meeting taking place via Zoom and on campus in Room 21 on **Tuesday, April 25th at 5PM.**

The LCAP is a three-year plan that describes the goals of Blue Oak to support positive student outcomes. At this meeting you will learn about the metrics used for each goal, the specific actions taken to meet each goal, and what we have achieved so far. You will also have an opportunity to give input on what further actions you would like the school take to achieve these goals. Our current school goals are as follows:

- 1. Provide a safe, healthy, equity based environment focused on meeting the needs of the whole child with well trained staff and a Common Core inclusive curriculum through a Waldorf inspired pedagogy.***
- 2. Provide an educational program that fully engages the whole child and family, supporting emotionally healthy individuals and community.***
- 3. Provide a strong academic program designed to meet the needs of the whole child.***
