 - Susan Domenighini went over the Executive Director's Report. This report can be viewed on the schools website under Councils & Committees. Additionally, our ERC has been calculated, it should be about \$500+ should be approved by the IRS to be cashed to the schools account within the month. We are also continuing to market our school since the need is still there. We currently have 12 students on our Kindergarten waitlist which, if we can get at least 18, we can open a third Kindergarten class at Blue Oak. That will help with our overall stability of the school in the long run. We are also looking at a few more ads in Growing Up Chico along with the ads we already have in the North State Parent Magazine. Additionally, we are looking at running our brand videos that MC2 created as commercials on public television in the local area, specifically targeting families with soon-to-be Kindergarten-aged students.

 - As we announced recently, Turner Impact has left the charter school building arena so we have been looking for someone new to help us with that. We have had a number of people reach out to Susan since to talk about those options. We will be discussing these options in more detail at the BOCC; the Finance Committee needs to be in the loop as well.
 - ➤ Charter School Capital and Red Hook have a similar model as Turner Impact; they buy it, build it and then sell it back to us. Charter School Property Solutions and Educational Facilities Group work directly with tax-exempt bonds to build the school; this model is supposed to be more stable as far as the cost and easier to pay off. Information has been added to this month's packet to learn more about what each of these options will mean for Blue Oak.




