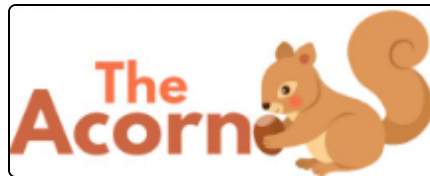




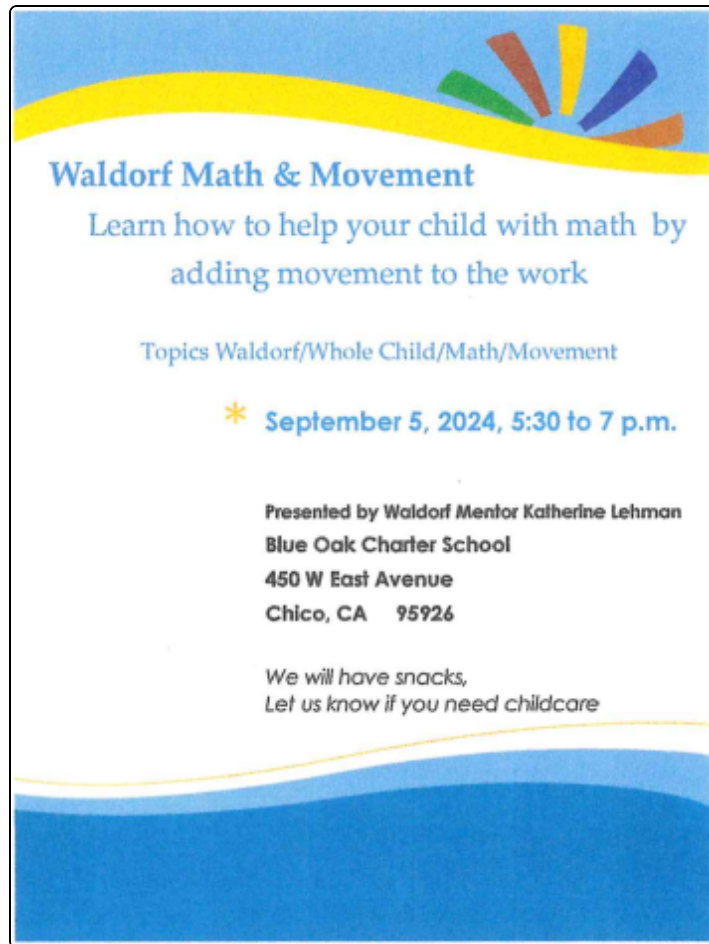

## **Drop Off**

When dropping off students between 7:45 and 8:15, please remember that we are set up for parents to turn right at the stop sign, then turn left and drive around the school. There are two drop-off points on each side of the building. The Lower Grades Double Doors will be open in the morning so children can go directly into the building rather than through the black gate.

We know many people are in a hurry in the morning, and we thank you for your courtesy and patience.

## **Pick Up Policy**

The school's pickup policy requires students to be picked up by 3:15 PM.

Any students not picked up by this time will be taken to the office. In these cases, a parent must come into the office to physically sign out their child. If late pickups occur multiple times, the school will work with the family to create a plan to ensure on-time pickup in the future. Thank you for your assistance in maintaining a smooth dismissal process and ensuring all students are accounted for at the end of the school day.
