Rose Ceremony



New After School Club Added




CSPP Corner

This year's theme, "Expanding Learning, Expanding Minds," encapsulated our mission to cultivate an environment of growth and learning for after-school and expanded learning professionals, including school day administrators and community school staff.



This highly attended, engaging two-day conference featured numerous breakout sessions covering a diverse range of topics from the Community School Initiative, S.T.E.A.M (science, technology, engineering, arts & mathematics), social emotional learning (SEL), positive youth development, and behavior intervention strategies among others. Additionally, on the first day (typically deemed Administrator Day), the keynote speaker explored impactful strategies to support the mental health and well-being of both students and adults in educational environments, delivering hope amidst ongoing challenges. Moreover, attendees learned how collaboration across multiple funding initiatives can streamline efforts to support whole child development, offering school administrator's practical strategies to align resources, reduce stress, and foster positive, equitable learning environments for all students.
