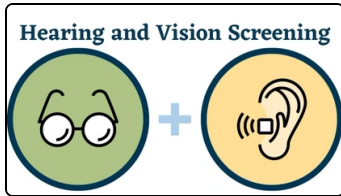
Pizza was generously provided by Woodstock Pizza, adding a welcoming touch to the evening.

- Help them reach their goal for an unforgettable trip to Santa Cruz.

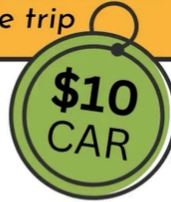
