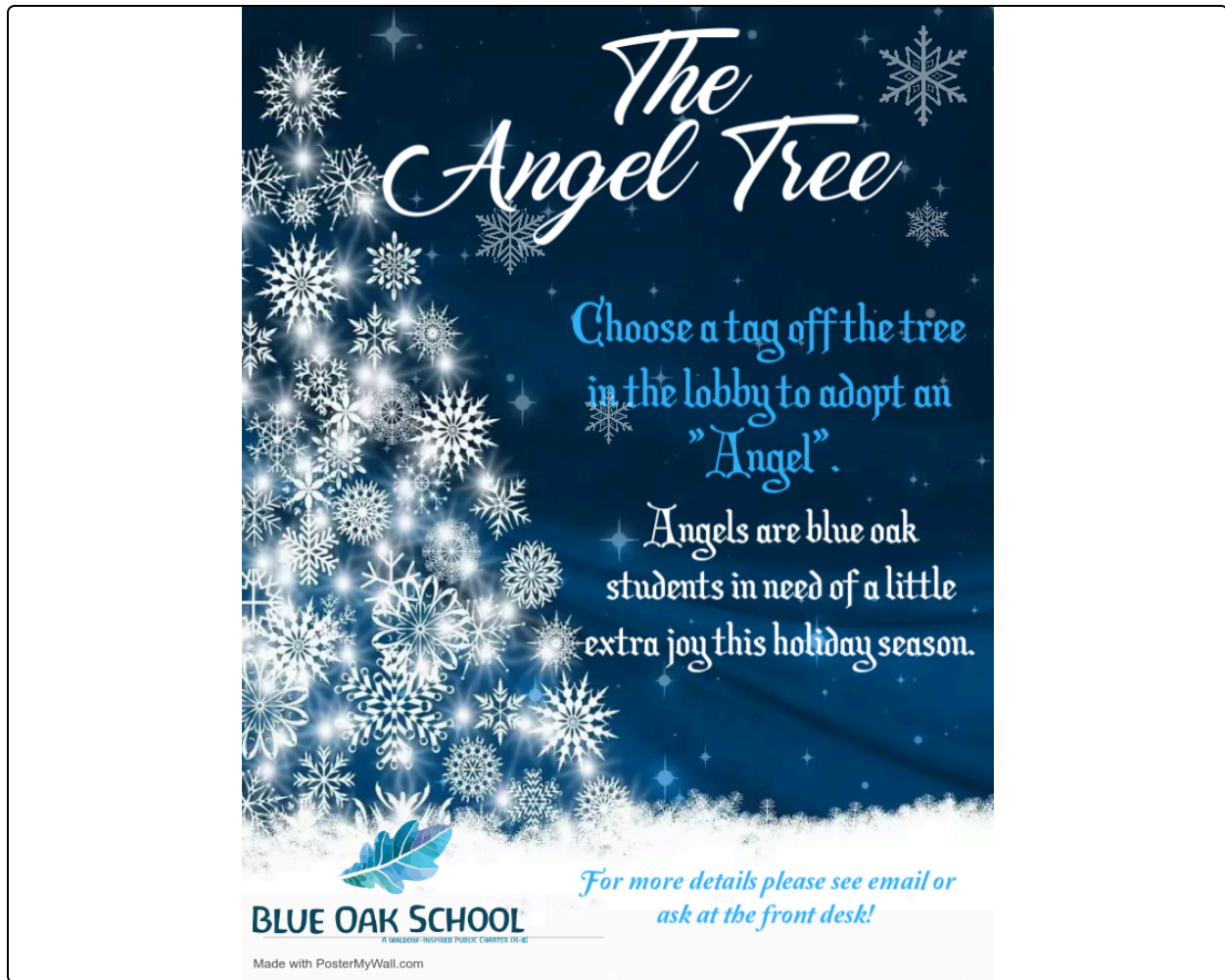

Reminder to be actively checking for lice, and remind students not to share personal belongings.

Rainy Day Clothing

We want to ensure our students remain comfortable and healthy during outdoor activities, especially during wet weather conditions. We've noticed that many children are getting wet from playing in puddles and then do not have dry clothing to change into. To help address this, we kindly ask that you:

1. Dress your child in weather-appropriate clothing
2. Include a complete change of clothes in their backpack
3. Provide waterproof or rain-resistant outerwear when needed
4. Pack extra socks and a plastic bag for wet items

By preparing an extra set of clothing, we can help your child stay dry and comfortable throughout the day, even after puddle adventures.
